Footnotes

BERMUDA SUNSET steadied behind traffic leaving the chute, was settled outside, split rivals three wide on the turn, gained a clear path leaving the bend, rallied to gain the lead inside the final furlong then was driven clear. COMANCHE MAN contested the pace just off the inside, moved clear leaving the turn, was challenged from outside upper stretch, no match for BERMUDA SUNSET in the late going but stayed clear for second. MEMO NUMBER FIVE away slowly, was then checked behind traffic, progressed just off the inside on the turn, had the rail into the stretch, took over third, altered out after entering the last furlong then could only hold his position. TENTH POWER disputed the pace just outside COMANCHE MAN to the last quarter mile then gradually wore down. BEAU'S HALO broke awkwardly and was checked, advanced inside on the turn to threaten leaving the bend but could not sustain his bid in the waning yards. STRIKE A SPIDER displayed early speed outside, began to back up on the turn, floated out leaving the bend and flattened. TATE DID IT was steadied behind traffic after the break, stayed off the inside through the turn and lacked a stretch bid. MINERO DE ORO was checked in traffic leaving the chute, raced in the second flight between horses, failed to stay close on the turn, fanned six wide leaving the bend and was empty. TOOLCRIB TOPPER chased the pacesetters from outside on the backstretch but faded leaving the bend. The rider of MEMO NUMBER FIVE lodged an objection alleging interference from COMANCHE MAN at the start. After their review, the stewards did not uphold the objection.
