Footnotes

FAKE THIS vied for the lead between horses, in path four through the bend, put to a drive entering the lane, under steady urging and edged ahead late. SPECIAL EGO prominent from outside, lost ground taking the turn five to six wide then rallied too late the final furlong. SHES A BLUE disputed the pace between rivals, fought gamely three wide in the stretch but could not close the gap. MISS A T M MACHINE set a pressured pace just off the inside, moved ahead upper stretch but did not have enough left the final sixteenth. TOM ES LA BULLY soon trailed, swung out widest on the turn, in path seven entering the stretch and gradually made up ground. QUEEN RING A DING in contention from the beginning, saved ground taking the bend and slowly wore down for the drive. SPECIAL BEANS prominent inside, angled two wide nearing the bend, floated out to path five leaving the turn then gradually angled in lacking a stretch bid. GOLD MEDAL HUNTER a step slow at the break, was a brief contender but faded four wide on the turn.
