MCKENNA'S JUSTICE was reserved towards the rear of the field, steadied off heels near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted three wide approaching the quarter-pole, lugged inward in upper stretch, moved to the rail and rallied near the furlong marker, moved out a bit near the sixteenth-pole, closed fast between rivals and prevailed under strong handling. NUGGETS PLEASE broke awkwardly then was forced in, lingered well back in the field, raced four then three wide on the far turn, moved out near the furlong marker, closed well to make a bid in the final sixteenth but failed to match the winner late. CATARUSKY broke inward and bumped with a rival, raced four then three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, drew even near the seven-sixteenths pole, dueled between rivals on the far turn, battled determinedly in the stretch but was outfinished while able to get the show. BANG ON raced three wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, contested the pace on the outside, dueled inside on the far turn, battled determinedly in the stretch but was also outfinished and missed the show. LATE NITE DECISION was taken up while in tight entering the first turn, raced three wide on that turn, was forwardly placed in the field, drew even with the leaders near the seven-sixteenths pole, dueled three wide on the far turn, battled into deep stretch and weakened late. WOKE UP SINGIN lagged well back in the field, raced three then four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. JOHNS LION bumped with a rival at the start, was in tight while rank nearing the first turn, raced five wide early on that turn then dropped to three wide, settled on the outside and lacked the needed rally. CLASSIC LEADER came in at the start, was in tight nearing the first turn, settled off the pace and failed to rally. THREESEAMFASTBALL veered in at the start, contested the pace on the inside and faded. LUCKY LITTLE LEE broke inward at the start, was in tight nearing the first turn and taken up, was in tight again midway through the first turn and faltered. (Rail at 10 Feet)
